Introduction

In the sacristy of the church of Santa Maria in Vallicella (also known as the Chiesa Nuova) – Congregation of the Oratory of Saint Philip Neri – two exceptional Christian priestly vestments in linen and silk decorated with feather mosaics are preserved. Dated between the late seventeenth and the early eighteenth century, they were produced in the western regions of New Spain by P'urhépecha artists.

<i>Description of the Collection</i>	Two different sets of priestly vestments, distinguished by their colour as “green” and “yellow”, both characterised by complex floral motifs. The “green” set, in which the feathers are sewn, includes chasuble, mitre with lappets, maniple, stole, burse and chalice veil. The “yellow” set, with glued feathers, includes chasuble, mitre with lappets, maniple, stole and chalice veil.
<i>History of the collection</i>	The “green” set can be dated between the late seventeenth and the early eighteenth century, while the “yellow” set seems to be some decades later, that is, fully eighteenth-century.

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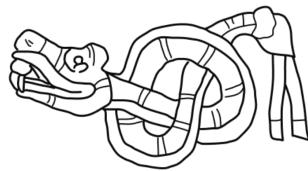
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
